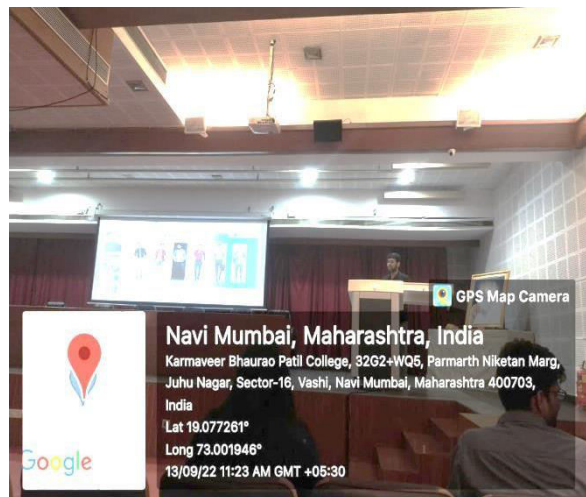

Speaker focused on the problems faced by transgender in society like not getting proper access to education, no identity in the society, hurdles in getting bank loans, no proper settlement etc. Speaker also mentioned about transgender phobia in the society and measures to be taken to eliminate the same. Explanations were also given about trans male, trans female etc. The session also focused on how the transgender birth occurs and also mentioned the ‘Transgender right protection act’. This act is to spread awareness to accept them into the society. Speaker has given several examples related to the problems faced by transgender in various parts of India. One of the highlighted examples was the issue of Metro recruitment in Cochin and resigned in a week because of not getting accommodation around.
