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Reading of Agenda:

- Motion from Prof. (Smt) Patil S.S.: To approve the agenda for 26thSeptember 2018.

Business:

- **Motion 1**[from Prof. (Smt) Patil S.S]: **Approval for the Board of Examination.**

Discussion: Prof. (Smt) Patil S.S. has introduced the newly form Board of Examination to all the present members. The members approved the formation of new Board of Examination.

- **Motion 2**[from Prof. (Smt) Patil S.S]: **Approval for Conduction of various Examination for all programs offered by the college.**

Discussion: Prof. (Smt) Patil S.S. has explained to the member that the Board of Examination will be conducting examinations for all courses offered under different programmes. This includes examination for the courses such as (a) Economics, English, Psychology, Philosophy, Geography, Foundation Course in B.A. Programme, (b) Accountancy and Commerce in B.Com programme, (c) Chemistry, Physics, Mathematics, and Micro-biology in B.Sc programme, (d) Computer Science, Information Technology, Biotechnology, Bioanalytical Sciences, B.M.S., B.B.I., and

B.A.F. in Self-finance Programme, (e) Food Processing and Technology in B.Voc. Programme, (f) Chemistry, Physics, Mathematics, Micro-biology, Commerce, Economics, Bioanalytical Sciences in P.G. Programme, and (g) Chemistry, Physics, Micro-Biology, Commerce in Ph.D. Programme.

- **Motion 3**[from Prof. (Smt) Patil S.S]: **Approval for Evaluation System for all Kinds of Examination.**

Discussion: Prof. (Smt) Patil S.S. has explained to the committee members that the college is following 60:40 pattern of evaluation for all courses offered by the college. In this 60 marks are for summative assessment which will be conducted as a Semester End Examination at the each semester. For this unitized question paper pattern is adopted. Whereas 40 mark weightage is allotted for Formative Examination which is the part of Continuous Internal Evaluation of students. This includes centralized internal test for 20 marks and Field work, Presentation, Open book test, Mini Projects, GD, Book review, Home assignment, Industrial visit & Report writing, Survey, Seminar, Societal activity, etc. for 20 marks.

For each of the internal assessment the rubrics are prepared and shared with the students to bring the objectivity in the assessment.

Prof. (Smt) Patil S.S. also emphasized that the committee adopted separate passing criterion for Semester End Examination and Continuous Internal Evaluation which includes 40% of the passing marks in each examination.

For those students who have enrolled for various programmes under university pattern the ATKT examination will be conducted as per the

University pattern only. Whereas for those students who have enrolled for first year of any programme offered by the college after the autonomy, the ATKT examination will be conducted as per the newly adopted evaluation pattern i.e. 60.40.

Ten point grading system will be used for converting the marks into grades:
