- Human participation in these studies isinescapable phenomenafor investigation concern.
- In recent years, researchers have increasingly ventured into topics that touch upon social
 and ethicaldilemmas and controversial subjects, enjoys investigation in diverse fields.
- The interest and integrity of researchers is societal responsibility.
- The research must be for integrity of society and nation, they are funded from government and non-government agencies across India.
- The purpose of Research Ethical committee is to maintain integrity in ongoing scientific research practices, good scientific reporting practices and Anti-plagiarism practices.
- the UGC has recommended that each institution has its own Office ofResearchIntegrity(ORI)atthelocal level (Patwardhanet al, 2020).
- Generalethicalprinciplesandethicalstandards laid by the American Psychological Association (APA) has enlisted general ethical principles for participation of humans in research: Integrity, Justice, Rights and dignity of people, Loyalty, Kindness and nonmaleficence

Objectives of Research Ethical committee

- To respect human dignity and reliability
- To ensure transparency and honesty towards research areas
- To respect individual freedom in relevant research
- To protect individual by research
- To ensure confidentiality and privacy
- To Promote impartiality and comprehensiveness
- To minimize harm
- To maximize benefit
- To share benefit of research for betterment of society
- To respect and protect an environment for future



- To check personal rights of the participants (every living and non-living entities).
- Topenalties researcher if he or she violates personal rights of the participants
- To scrutinizeresearchproposalsthatmethodologiesinvolvinghumanparticipation
- To give guideline to researchers on survey based research with respect to informedconsent:
 aims, methods and voluntary participation, risk factor, time of survey, precautions, funding agencies, confidentiality
- To clarify the moto of research
- To explainanyissues relatingto copyrightof data and othermaterials used in theresearch.
- To ensure for following plagiarism policy.
- To take strong justification when some controversialmethodologies like covert research, internet research, social medial research

The important circumstances for the approval of the research proposal from a

research committee:

- It needstobecarefullyscrutinized in research when there is presence of Vulnerable participants such as children, refugees, irregular migrants, sex workers, peoplewith cognitive impairments, dissidents, traumatized people at risk of re-traumatization.
- The ethical committee reviews the proposal of the research before the study begins as well as during teproposed period.
- When the finding in research fall outside the scope of the research project then, the findings should be put in front of Research committee for approval.
- A research proposal may be classified as "minimal risk project"
- If the research project is beyond "minimal risk" level, it must be scrutinized research ethicscommittee



The guidelines about the constitution of the research ethics

- Research Ethics Committee must be multidisciplinary and multisectoral
- Members include individuals with scientific expertise, including expertise in behavioural orsocial sciences;
- Committee must include memberswhoarenotaffiliatedwith organization
- Committee should include at least five member with two non –affiliated members.

Coredocumentationrequired by Research Ethics Committee

- the research proposal, included with the exact methods and procedures to be followed
- a statement that no unethical deception of participants is involved, and no exaggeration ofproposedbenefits
- astatement of about confidentiality.

$The need for upgrading the knowledge of current good research practices for ethical committee \ members$

 The educational institution needs to organize training programmes for ethical committee members from time to time so as to maintain updated knowledge about research ethics.
