Warning against Ragging

- 1. Ragging is a crime. No one can feign ignorance of the law. In pursuance of the directions/decisions of Honorable Supreme Court of India, those who indulge in ragging can be punished with:
- (a) Jail for period ranging from six months to ten years.

(b) Fine up to Rs. 50,000/-

(c) Embossing of certificates that 'The student had indulged in to ragging' which will:

- Adversely affect career prospects.

- Adversely affect opportunities to go abroad for the students on whose certificates it would be embossed that he/she had indulged in to ragging as a result they will not get passport and visa.
- 2. As per Supreme Court ruling, the accused of ragging, depending upon the nature of act/offence, can also be tried under various provisions of the *Indian Penal Code (IPC)* some of them are as follows.

Sections of IPC	Offence	Punishment
319,320, 321,322, 323	Causing physical or mental harm- Hurt, Grievous hurt, Voluntarily or otherwise,	Jail term for One year or Rs.1000 fine or both
334	Causing hurt on being provoked	Jail term for One month or Rs.500 fine or both
335	Causing grievous hurt on being provoked	Jail term for Four years or Rs.2000 fine or both
336,337, 338	Endangering personal safety of others	Jail term from Three months to Two years or 500 Rs Rs 1000 or both
339	Wrongful restraint	Jail term for One month or Rs.500 fine or both
340	Wrongful confinement	Jail term for One year or Rs.1000 fine or both
349	Forcing a person to act against his/her will	Jail term for Three month or Rs.500 fine or both
350	Using criminal force	
351	Assaulting- To create apprehension of causing physical or mental hurt	
354	Assaulting or using criminal force against woman	Jail term for Two years or fine or both

3. Strict disciplinary action will also be taken by the faculty which may lead to rustication of the students who indulge in ragging.
