- **4.** Every semester, Ph.D scholar shall submit a progress report which contain the details such as Name, Enrolment No., date of Registration, date of Comprehensive Examination, date of Research Proposal Seminar, Title of the Thesis, Supervisor details, Progress made, details of Publications etc., (whichever is applicable) to the guide. After obtaining the signature of the guide, scholar shall upload the progress report in ERP which will be visible to all the Doctoral Committee members for their comments. Dean (R&C)/ ERP Team may take necessary action.
- **5.** Thesis Submission Meeting to be conducted online mode within 6 weeks of Research Colloquium Seminar. The duration of the meeting shall be 10-20 minutes. The scholars shall brief the organization of Thesis, different chapters, salient results and publications. If the Doctoral Committee finds the Thesis suitable for submission, the scholar shall submit the Thesis within 2 weeks of Thesis submission approval meeting.
- **6.** Final Defence shall be online mode only. The Guide may include two (local examiners) from the Institute in the panel of 6 (six) examiners.
- **7.** If the Doctoral Committee finds that 80% of the Thesis work is already published in at least two **'Q1 Journals'**, the Thesis would be examined in fast-track mode wherein the report will be sought from one of the local examiners. The Local Examiners may also be chosen from other departments.
- **8.** The selection of final examiner for Defence shall be done by the Guide in both normal and fast-track mode of evaluation.

The above matters are placed in the Senate for approval.
