Necessary Documents for New Admission 2025 B. Tech *(Along with the original documents, one set hard copy is to be brought during physical reporting):*

All documents in PDF format up to 1 MB allowed except Sl. No. 1 (Please also bring soft copy of each document with you)

1. Photo (100KB) and Signature (50KB) (in image format and not in PDF)
2. Printout of Registration form and Locked Choices and Provisional Seat Allotment letter.
3. Document Verification cum Seat Acceptance letter.
4. Admit Card of JEE (Main).
5. Score Card of JEE (Main)
6. Class X (High School) Board Certificate / AADHAR as proof of date of birth.
7. Pass Certificate and Marks sheet of qualifying examination.
8. Photo ID proof (Adhar card/Ration card/Voter/Pan card)
9. School Leaving/Transfer certificate
10. Anti-Ragging Undertaking
11. Physical fitness certificate or Medical Certificate
12. Proof of State of Eligibility (Class XII certificate / marksheet providing name of school)
13. Migration certificate from last Institute/Univ./School attended.
14. Character and conduct certificate from the institution last attended.

20. OCI/PIO Card (in case of OCI/PIO Candidate) (for DASA only)
21. Passport (for DASA only)

Anti-Ragging Undertaking (Compulsory for all):

1. Generate the Anti-Ragging Undertaking Online for National Institute of Technology Mizoram (U-0617)

Step 2: On the homepage, click on “Undertaking”.

Step 3: Click on “Register” to start the process of filling out the anti-ragging affidavit.

Income Certificate (if applicable):

Income Certificate (For less than 1 Lakh category and Between 1-5 Lakh category), to be issued by the State Govt./Competent Authority **for the financial year 2024-2025** and academic year 2025-2026.

NOTE:

- Income Certificate should be in the name of the parents of the concerned student (s). Student's name will not reflect on the Income Certificate.
- Income Certificates based on financial year 2023-2024 will not be considered.
- The income certificate would be required to be certified by an authorised officer not below the rank of Tehsildar in the States/UTs.

DOCUMENTS TO BE SUBMITTED DURING PHYSICAL REPORTING (B. TECH)

- In addition to Income Certificate, it is mandatory to submit an affidavit (format is available on Institute website), on Rs. 100/- non-judicial stamp paper, signed by the parents declaring the income for the financial year 2024-2025, for claiming waiver of tuition fee.

OBC-NCL Certificate and EWS Certificate (if applicable):

- The Certificates shall be issued for the financial year 2024-2025 and academic year 2025-2026.
- The income and assets of the families would be required to be certified by an authorised officer not below the rank of Tehsildar in the States/UTs.
