DISCUSSED THAT



- When New Educational policy will be implemented existing course structure will change from certificate course, diploma, degree and honours. From coming academic year, we need to rearrange the papers to make sure that student get proper exit route as well as matching with the credits offered in general by other colleges/ University.
- Mr Sanjay Ranade highlighted the fact that post the implementation of NEP Administrative work is going to increase at high, therefore college must develop Computer Based mechanism.
- Concern was raised with respect to Academic Bank of credit, it is difficult to have smooth synchronization between different Educational Institutes therefore we should be able to do educational tie up.
- Courses related to research; basics skill enhancement can be completed by students from outside the college. Our college should give recognition to the institutes offering such courses. For example, computer software's can be completed by the student from private Institute or government recognised portal and that will be recognised as a Credit earned in our program.


DISCUSSED THAT
