DISCUSSED THAT

Coordinator of the course Dr Mohsina Mukadam briefly explained the members present on the board about the earlier pattern of assessments or the evaluation process and requested



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them to give their recommendations and suggestions .For general component papers it was recommended that within the 40:60 pattern, 60 marks should be allotted for written

examination (External evaluation) and 40 marks should be kept for internal assessments (Internal evaluation) wherein we blend multiple choice questions with assignments.

The skilled based paper pattern remains unchanged.

Mr Sushant Pilankar appreciated the efforts taken in blending the syllabi and agreed with the suggested changes put forth by the Coordinator. He did stressed on having Digital

Marketing for the students to which the Coordinator mentioned on having it included from this academic year itself.

Ms Amrita Gokhale suggested to keep paper pattern as a comprehensive one since the students might find it difficult to write a full 60 marks paper. The Coordinator welcomed

this suggestion but also mentioned on having a writing practice for the students along with following the UGC norms to which Ms Gokhale agreed upon.

Dr Varsha Muley too supported the practice of 60 marks writing for the general component papers.

Dr Mohsina Mukadam then informed the members of introducing this paper pattern for the General Component for the first Year students for academic year 2022-2023 and will

continue in subsequent academic years. However these changes were not applicable to the present Second year and the Third year students.

RESOLVED THAT

The 40:60 component with respect to 40 marks Internal Evaluation and 60 marks External Evaluation in the form of Written Exam shall be implemented from the current academic year for the first year students and continued to be practiced for the subsequent academic years.
