**Agenda Item No. 1:** To seek approval for the change in the Syllabi, the change in the number of credits and the modalities of assessment for the M.Sc. Program.

**DISCUSSED THAT**

- The CBCS system with the changes in credits was discussed and approved.
- Dr. Shashikant Vaidya suggested the addition of two theories - Rational emotive behavior therapy (REBT) and Transactional analysis (TA); in the AECC portion of semester 1.
- Dr. Sanjeev Waghmare suggested that the Internship should be for the entire semester for 6 months without any theory or practical papers.
- Dr. Indu Anna George, Dr. Sanjeev Waghmare and Dr. Shashikant Vaidya suggested that the marking scheme for internship/project work for semester 3 should be changed. Evaluation of the students work should be done by both the college as well as the institute hosting the internship. 50 marks were allotted for the Institute's evaluation of the student on the criteria of work ethic, conduct of experiments, punctuality and attendance.
- The detailed changes in the syllabus were shown.

**RESOLVED THAT**

The changes were incorporated for the PG syllabus and the suggestions were noted.

**Agenda Item No. 2:** To seek approval for the M.Sc. Entrance examination pattern.
