Agenda Item No. 1: To approve the Certificate Courses with syllabi, duration, costing and evaluation, if any.

DISCUSSED THAT : With few suggestions everyone agreed with the syllabus of the Certificate course in Basic Sanskrit. Dr. Gadgil found it very interesting. Dr. Kulkarni suggested, as the syllabus seems in line with interdisciplinary, it would be better if we mention it in the preamble. He also suggested, in the preamble emphasis should be given on the fact that the course can be co-related / is suitable to the different courses offered by the Mumbai University like mythology, manuscriptology, mysticism etc.

RESOLVED THAT: The syllabus for Certificate course in Basic Sanskrit was unanimously agreed by all the members.

Agenda Item No. 2: To decide on the changes in the modalities of assessment, is any, which includes the question paper pattern, for internal and external examination.

DISCUSSED THAT : Through feedback TY students suggested few changes in paper V of the 6th semester. The first question of the same paper carries 15 marks where students are supposed to recognise the Sandhi and solve it with mentioning the required rules for it. To cover most of the rules it was suggested to divide this question into part A and B. In part B students can be asked to explain some of the rules.

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RESOLVED THAT: This suggestion was unanimously agreed by all the members.

Resolution Agenda Item No. 3: To discuss the courses from Swayam and MOOC.

DISCUSSED THAT: Dr. Dabke found that there are few courses available on Swayam, but the topics get covered by the certificate course and also Sambhashan course provided by the college itself.

Regarding this fact Dr. Kulkarni suggested, college can design such a course which will be proved beneficial for the students preparing for IAS, as there is hardly any institution that provides classes for students who have taken up Sanskrit for the UPSC.

He also suggested, to enlarge the horizon of the Sanskrit in terms of students, course can be designed keeping in the mind students who want to opt for Ayurveda (BAMS) and Science.

RESOLVED THAT: There was total agreement on this fact by all the members.
