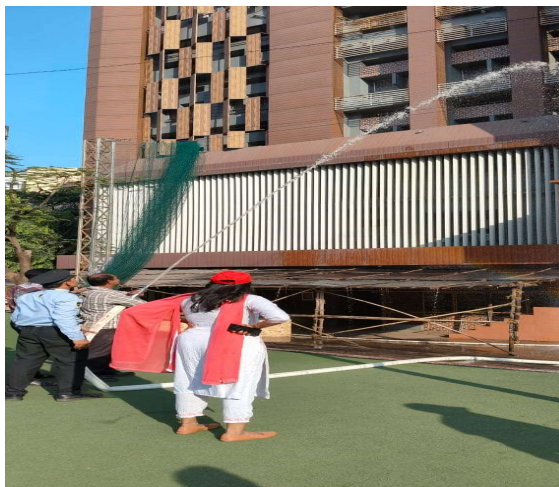
Objectives: The Fire Marshal Mock Drill at a college aims to familiarize staff and students with fire safety protocols and ensure efficient evacuation during an emergency.

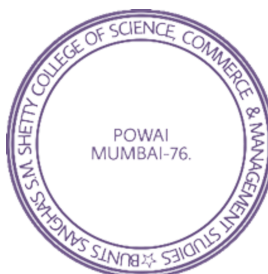
