Students can register their names till 18th September 2019.



6 Days – 5 Nights

Day 1: Report Bandra Terminus at 12:00 pm to catch the train no.12480 Suryanagri exp. at 13:30pm. Overnight train journey.

Day 2: Arrival in Jodhpur at 6:35am: Pickup from Railway Station by placard carrying driver and transfer to your respected Hotel. After breakfast proceed to Mehrangarhfort ,Jaswanthhada and Umeedbhawan museum, After lunch visit local market of Jodhpur. Overnight stay at hotel.

Day 3: Jodhpur – Jaisalmer: After breakfast check out then proceed for Sightseeing & After lunch drive to Jaisalmer. On arrival check in to hotel. In evening visit to market. Dinner in hotel. Overnight at Jaisalmer.

Day 4: Jaisalmer-Sam Sand Dunes: After breakfast visit to Jaisalmer sightseeing like as Fort , War museum , badabagh , Patwonkiheveli , Gadisaltalab, and after lunch evening visit Sam / Khuri for Camel ride and Rajasthani Traditional dinner at Dunes with dance and music. Overnight at Jaisalmer.

Day 5 :Jaisalmer – Jodhpur Drop : After breakfast check-out. enjoyjeely safari (Self pay) and leave for jodhpur railway station, Enrouted take lunch and In evening drop at jodhpur railway station to board train Suryanagri Exp. no.12479 at 6:45pm. Packed dinner in train

Day 6: Reaches Mumbai at 11:35am. Journey end with lots of sweet memories. (breakfast served in train)

B.Com Department Industrial Visit
Jodhpur & Jaisalmer

Date: 25th January, 2020 to 30th January, 2020

Rajasthan has always been one of the most wanted places to visit in the world. It is cultured and traditional. It is considered to be a spot for the highest tourist attraction. It is among the most visited places of the country.

The country by itself has had the fortune to preserve this amazing heritage and the beauty it withholds. The trip consisted of more than 157 students and 6 teachers.

Herewith is the report in order to enhance the wonderful experience we had at this breathtaking place.

DAY 1

The students were asked to assemble at Bandra Terminus at 11:45 a.m. to embark on the journey via the Suryanagri Express. The entire day and the remainder of the night was spent in the train.

Day 2

We reached the Jodhpur station at 6:35 in the morning. The hotel allotted for our stay was the 'MAPLE INN'. Breakfast was served in the hotel. After a nourishing breakfast the students freshened up and departed for sight-seeing.

MEHRANGARH FORT:

The Mehrangarh fort is one of the largest forts of India. As mentioned earlier Rajasthan is the land of king and kingship and what is a kingdom without a fort?

It consists of many articles used in mainly the ancient and the middle age period. The articles at the sight included chalices, various pottery items, a hookah pot, swords and coins and stamps used by the king.

The fort also consisted of a Sheesh Mahal which means the entire room was built of only mirrors. It was considered as one of the most privileged places where only certain classes of people could enter. The fort was an amazing source of knowledge for swordsmanship. It also has a temple within its vicinity.

After the trip to the fort the students then explored the Jodhpur Market.

Day 3

The visit to Jodhpur had ended and we embarked on the journey to Jaisalmer

CAMEL SAFARI: It was the essence of true tradition and excitement. The sight was mastered by the art of the universe in the beauty of the setting sun and the

Sam Sun Dunes. The sand dunes had a wave like structure and it was caused due to the wind.

After the camel safari we moved to the stay at the tent. The temperature was dropping by the minute and the staff then welcomed us traditionally and with music and dance. There was a DJ organized for the students and the evening was spent with laughter and fun.

Day 4

Jaisalmer Fort: It is the only fort in India to have people still live in it. There were women who were selling handmade jewelry, puppets and clothing items. This fort places accommodation for tourists, allows the people to reside in it. Holds one of the largest shopping areas of Jaisalmer.

Paitwon Ki Haveli

This is the largest haveli in the entire state of Rajasthan. It is interconnected to the other 5 havelis of that particular place. There is still a family that resides in this Haveli. The fine art engraved on each of these walls were still very well visible.

Day 5

This day was the day that our Industrial Visit was conducted. We visited 'SARAS DAIRY FARM.' The dairy industry of Rajasthan contributes to a major chunk of the state's income. The person then working at the dairy farm told us what they do in order to process the milk that they get from registered people across the state. The state has provided registration numbers to the people involved in supplying, milk to this dairy farm and hence the dairy farm can only accept the supplies from such individuals.

The farmers are paid on the basis of how much milk do they bring and how much fat is present in the milk. The milk is boiled at 72 degrees. It is boiled in order to get the bacteria killed. It is then cooled at 8 degrees. It is cooled in the cold storage for at least 2 to 3 hours, the milk is then segregated in the milk tank and the cream tank, the milk segregated in the cream tank is then put for further processing to make products such as butter and butter milk. After this process is done they fill it in packets of 5 kg. The product is usually sent for product testing in the product section.

After the industrial visit we boarded the Suryanagri Express that left the Jodhpur station at 19:00 hours.

DAY 6: We reached Bandra Terminus t 11:30.
