Report on "Visit to RBI" by Department of Economics

The Department of Economics had organized a one day visit to RBI museum and banking hall on 16th July 2019 for second year students of B.Com. The students were taken to RBI's office at CST along with two teachers Prof. Prachiti Pawaskar and Prof. Sandeśha Shetty. The students reached the venue by 11:00 am and visited the banking hall where they attended a lecture delivered by Mr. Kishor Gohil, Deputy Treasurer of Cash Department. He explained the structure of cash deposits and withdrawals through currency chest which is situated in Nasik. Also he has thrown some light on Financial Inclusion and awareness. The overall session was very interactive. Then the students proceeded with another session wherein they have witnessed functioning of the RBI. Later they watched a documentary on the evolution of currency in India.

The students visited the RBI museum where they saw the currency in different form in India and various other forms of money used since ages in India. There were photos of Governors of RBI since 1937.

The students also learnt the various techniques of identifying the real currency which is in circulation. They also exchanged the coins in the banking hall.

The visit was primarily an educational visit but real time dynamics that students got to learn was something which enriched their knowledge beyond textbooks.
