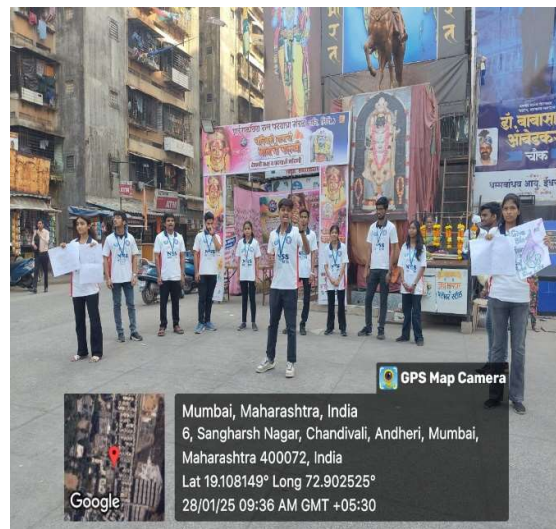
Objectives: To educate and inspire the community about the importance of blood donation and its impact on saving lives.

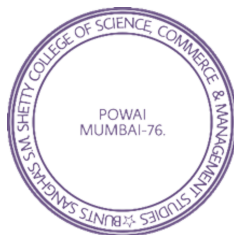
