The Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) of the college is established to ensure and enhance the quality of education and various other aspects of institutional functioning. The activities and achievements of IQAC during the academic year 2023-24 are summarized as under:

Second cycle of NAAC: College has successfully completed the Peer Team Visit of NAAC on 27th and 28th June 2023. The NAAC Peer Team comprised of Chairperson - Dr. Ravi Bheemaiah Krishnan (Vice-Chancellor Koppala University & Professor at Government Engineering College Campus, Talakal, Koppala), Member Co-ordinator - Dr. Nasib Singh Gill (Head Department of Computer Science and Applications & Director, Digital Learning Centre M. D. University Rohtak) and Member - Dr. Jatinder Kaur Sidhu (Principal, Guru Gobind Singh College for Women, Chandigarh). The visit had principal presentation, departmental presentation, visits to departments and facilities, interaction with various stakeholders and interaction with IQAC. The visit was successfully concluded with an exit meeting. The results of the NAAC second cycle were declared on 17th July 2023. College secured 3.32 CGPA with A+ grade.

Best College Award: The College was awarded with the Best College Award from University of Mumbai for the year 2021-22.

12(b) from UGC: College obtained 12(b) from UGC for research grants in October 2023.

Autonomous Status to College: The College applied for autonomous status on 10th November 2023 and received notification from UGC on 31st January 2024 regarding the same. College will be functioning with academic autonomous status along with NEP 2020 from the academic year 20204-25.

Deekasharambh: Student Induction Programme 'Deekasharambh – 2023-2024' as per UGC Guidelines was organized on 14th and 15th July 2023. Day 1 oriented the students with introduction to the institution, and facilities like Learning Resource Center, Student's Council and Counselling Centre. Day 2 introduced the students to their respective departments and various committees and associations of the college.

Collaborations:

College entered into collaboration with Devjyot Pyramid Meditation, Mumbai on 22nd September, 2023 and a programme 'The Art of Meditation' was organised.

The Department of Information Technology of the college entered into an academic collaboration with ICL College, Khed, Maharashtra on 16th Sept, 2022 which was renewed in 2023 too. Students of ICL Khed College visited S.M. Shetty College on 5th March 2024 and students from S.M. Shetty College visited ICL College, Khed on 18th March 2024. The students from both colleges learnt and

explored each other's colleges, new places and culture.

Parental and Alumni workshop: Parental workshops on nurturing youth, parenting the young adult and alumni annual meet was organised as an annual practice.

Research Centre in Commerce: University of Mumbai has approved Ph.D. Centre in the faculty of Commerce and in the subject 'Business Policy and Administration' leading to Ph.D. degree from October 2017 onwards. Eight students are already registered.

The Student Research Forum has encouraged students to develop a research bent of mind and scientific temper to involve in research activities. Students are encouraged and guided to actively participate and present research papers in 'Avishkar', a State level Research Convention. Fifty-One students participated in Avishkar 2023-24, and Mr. Waman Dhuri from M.Com got selected for the final round.

Research Cell: Research Cell is very active and organizes several programmes to augment research activities. The Research Cell of the college has taken the initiative to promote research among faculty and students. To encourage research, 'Seed Money' is provided to both the faculty and the students. During the academic year 2023-24, faculty members published many research papers and participated in more than 100 workshops / webinars / FDP's / conferences. During this academic year, Dr. Liji Santosh received a research grant of Rs. 90,000 from Indian Council of Social Science Research (ICSSR) for Minor Research Project.

Samabaav Film Festival

The Women Development Cell of Bunts Sangha's S M Shetty Degree College, Powai, on 18th August, 2023 organised Samabhav - an International film festival in collaboration Men Against Violence and Abuse (MAVA). The film festival was organised to promote Gender Equality among the youth through films surrounding the topic. The panel of discussants consisted of Harish Sadani - Co-Founder of MAVA, Faiz Ullah - Assistant Professor at the School of Media and Cultural Studies at TISS, Mohamed Altamash Khan - Senior Gender Trainer and Program Coordinator at MAVA, Swapnil Shete - Filmmaker and Anuj Bhatt - Digital and Cultural Advocacy Coordinator.

A presentation of the report on TISS-US Consulate Study titled "Light, Camera and Time for Action: Gender Equality and Hindi Cinema" was presented by Professor Faiz Ullah. The presentation showcased the misogynistic ideology that exists in the Hindi cinema. The screenings were followed by an open conversation among the students and panelists, on various issues of gender and inclusivity.

My Part of The Story

My Part of The Story was organised to create a supportive and engaging environment for students where they can openly share their issues, fostering empathy and understanding among participants. Resource persons for the session were counsellor Madhura Pandey & Adv Jyoti Sharma. The 'Sakhi Box' was kept in the open area for students in which they could put the chits related to any problem faced by them, anonymously, so that they don't feel uncomfortable to share their problems. The session started with reading the chits one by one, where Adv Jyoti Sharma provided legal perspective and counsellor, Madhura Pandey provided psychological aspects on gender biases, peer pressure, ragging and many more. The atmosphere was conducive and participants felt at ease as they comfortably engaged in interactive discussion with the resource person.

Self Defense

The Self-Defence Workshop, organized by the Women Development Cell (WDC), took place on September 15, 2023, in the SM Shetty Auditorium. This event aimed to empower individuals with essential self-defense skills and techniques to ensure their safety and security. The workshop was conducted by two experienced instructors, Santosh Thambur and Siby Antony, who brought a wealth of knowledge and expertise in self-defense.

Gender Sensitisation Course

An online certificate course on gender sensitisation was organised free of cost for all students. Students could access the self-paced class at a time convenient to them, access the material and appear for a test. Twenty four students completed the course successfully

The program saw a significant turnout of participants eager to learn about cancer prevention strategies. Internal Committee

The discussions circled around robust legal framework under the POSCO Act for the protection of children from offences of sexual assault, sexual harassment and pornography, while safeguarding the interest of the child at every stage of the judicial process. The various provisions of POSCO Act were highlighted, including confidentiality of the victim's identity, gender-neutral provisions, mandatory reporting of abuse cases, and child-friendly investigation and trial procedures. Camp Activities

The Mandala Art Workshop provided the participants with not only a creative outlet but also a powerful tool for self-expression through pattern & vibrant colors. Feedback for the same was taken through google forms & total 25 students had participated. All the participants were issued e-certificates.
- The Creative Club had organized an event named 'Eco Friendly Ganesh Idol Making' in collaboration with the National Service Scheme on 14th September 2023. The Resource Person for this workshop was our very own TYBBI student Mr. Tejas Mohite. The main objective of this workshop was to educate participants about eco-friendly Ganapati making practices, empowering them with the knowledge & skill to create Ganapati idols in an environmentally sustainable manner, thereby promoting a greener and more eco-conscious celebration of the festival. Feedback for the same was taken through google forms and a total of 42 students had participated.
- To celebrate the divinity of Navratri, the Creative Club had organized 'Navrang 2023', a nine days color festival on its Social Media Handle @hoonar_thecreativeclub, where all the students and even the teachers had to get ready in the Navratri color outfit each day and click a picture of them or along with their class groups and submit the same through the Google link provided by the club. The Google link accepted entries from 15th October to 25th October 2023 between 7am to 3pm every day. All the entries were posted on the Instagram handle of Hoonar, the creative club. The event was open for all the students as well as teachers. A total number of 61 entries were collected by the Google link where students and teachers of various departments participated.

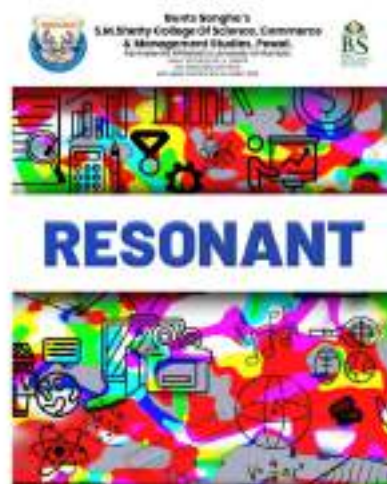
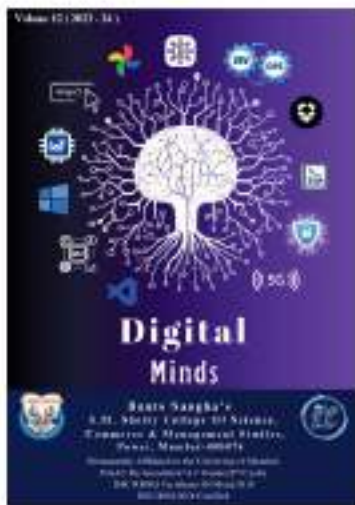
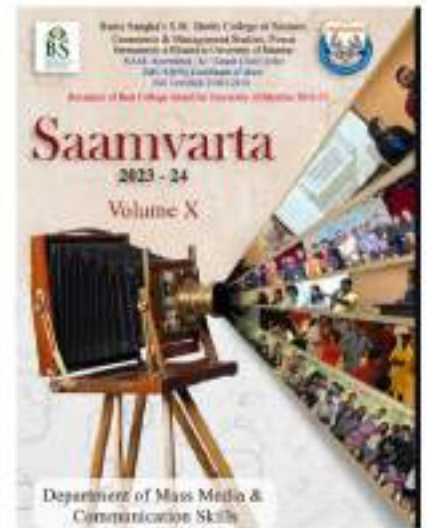

CONVOCATION CEREMONY 2023-24



“पुनः प्रयोजन करना अनिवार्य होना चाहिए”

Successful Blood Donation and Thalassemia Screening Camp at SM Shetty College



In a remarkable display of altruism and community engagement, the NSS unit of SM Shetty College of Science, Commerce, and Arts, Management Studies, in collaboration with KDMC-Shaastri Nagar Hospital-Childanand Charitable Trust Blood Centre, organized a highly successful Blood Donation and Thalassemia Screening Camp on February 10, 2024.

The event, which unfolded aimed to address the escalating demand for blood while promoting the paramount importance of voluntary blood donation. Distinguished personalities, including Principal Dr. Sushil Shetty, Dr. Laj Samish, CS Sandesh Shetty, NSS Programme Officer Dr. Vipay Vishwakarma, Asst. Prof. John Menezes, Asst. Prof. Vinay Shukparkar and Asst. Prof. Hriti Parakh, graced the occasion, endorsing the noble tradition of altruism.
