## **A Report on Industrial visit to Silvassa for SYBMS students (2023-24)**

An Industrial visit of one night two days was organised for the students of SYBMS students was organized on 6th and 7th March 2024. The group comprised of 44 students (29 Female, 15 Male), 2 teaching staff members had accompanied them.

### **DAY 1 : 06<sup>th</sup> March 2024**

Students assembled in college at 6:30 a.m. and departed for Silvassa via bus . A stop for breakfast was taken and then students were led on a pleasant excursion to the SHIVGIRI RESORT where students had their lunch and left for first industrial visit to **Alok Industries** . At first students were assembled and taken to the weaving unit , there the students had a close look at the rows of weaving machines with employees working continuously and the company official shared a lot of information about the unit . The students saw the weaving of t shirts , sweatpants etc. and the weaving of bag. Students got to know that Alok industries exports 25% of its products to over 90 countries and ensures high quality and efficient working of weaving unit and uses latest technology machines. After a walk at units students took group picture with the employees, by 5:30 pm the students and teachers departed from Alok industries and went back to Shivgiri resort.

### **DAY 2 : 07<sup>th</sup> March 2024**

Morning 7:30am , students enjoyed in the swimming pool and had a breakfast till 9:30 , everyone left for next destination at 10 am . 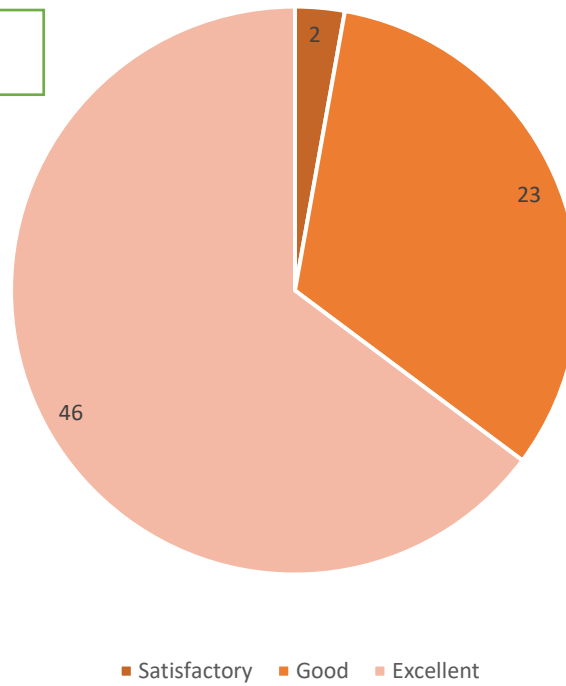
### How was the hospitality you experienced during the trip?

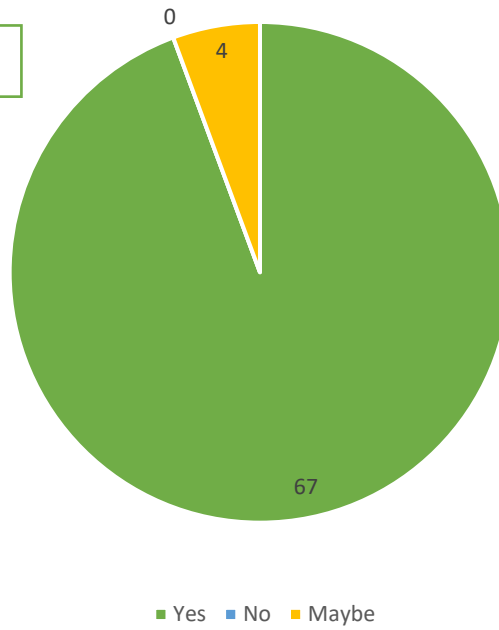
### How was your travelling experience? (Bus Journey)

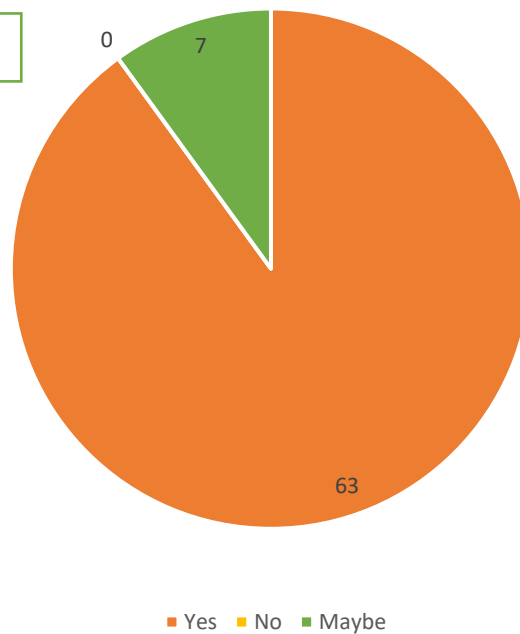
