

WOMAN DEVELOPMENT CELL POSH ACT SESSION REPORT

Date: 16th August 2024

Venue: 802 Room Time: 11:00 AM

On 16th of August 2024, the Women Development Cell & the Internal Committee of college held a session on the Prevention of Sexual Harassment (POSH) Act, 2013 by Asst. Prof. Adv. Jyoti Sharma at 11:00 AM in the 802 Room. The session aimed to educate students and faculty members about the importance of the POSH Act, its provisions, and its role in creating a safer and more respectful environment on campus and in the workplace.

The session began with the professor providing an overview of the historical context leading to the enactment of the POSH Act. She cited notable cases, such as the Vishaka vs. State of Rajasthan case in 1997, which was a pivotal moment in the history of workplace harassment laws in India. The Vishaka case involved the gang rape of Bhanwari Devi, a social worker in Rajasthan, which highlighted the urgent need for legal protections against sexual harassment in the workplace. This case led to the formulation of the Vishaka Guidelines by the Supreme Court of India, which eventually paved the way for the POSH Act, 2013.

The professor then provided an in-depth explanation of the POSH Act, 2013, emphasizing the following key aspects:

- 1. Definition of Sexual Harassment: briefly explained the difference between good & the bad touch & form in which sexual harassment can take place.
- 2. Applicability: applies to all workplace.
- 3. Internal Complaints Committee (ICC): how one facing these problems can report it to the ICC in their organization.
- 4. Grievance Redressal Mechanism: explained the process & timeline within which the complaint should be filed and the role of ICC addressing the complaint.
- 5. Penalties & consequences: explained the penalties & consequences which can be faced if the accused is proved guilty.

Following the detailed explanation, the session included an interactive discussion where students and faculty members were encouraged to ask questions and share their thoughts. The professor addressed queries related to the practical application of the Act, the challenges faced by complainants, and the role of bystanders in preventing harassment.

The session concluded with a strong emphasis on the importance of creating a culture of respect and safety within the college and beyond. The Asst. Prof. CA Zainab Rangwala, head of Internal Committee, urged everyone to be vigilant and proactive in addressing and preventing sexual harassment, reminding participants that the POSH Act is not just a legal mandate but a step towards fostering a dignified and secure environment for all.

The session was well-received by the attendees, who appreciated the insights and knowledge shared by the professor. It was a significant step in raising awareness about the POSH Act and empowering individuals to take action against sexual harassment in all its forms.
