The Internal Quality Assurance Cell of Bunts Sangh's S.M. Shetty College of Science, Commerce and Management Studies, Powai organized the Multidisciplinary International e-Conference on Redefining Business in Digital Era: Issues and Challenges on May 29, 2020.

The conference received an overwhelming response from the researchers. Nearly 280 research papers were received by the editorial team out of which 184 research papers were selected for three journals IJAIR (with 7.36 impact factor), Studies in Indian Place names (March Edition, UGC CARE listed) and Journal of Xi'an University of Architecture and Technology (SCOPUS).

The conference began with the Inaugural ceremony where the participants were introduced to the college and the conference by Mrs. Nidhi Chandorkar and Mr. Virendra Singh respectively.
