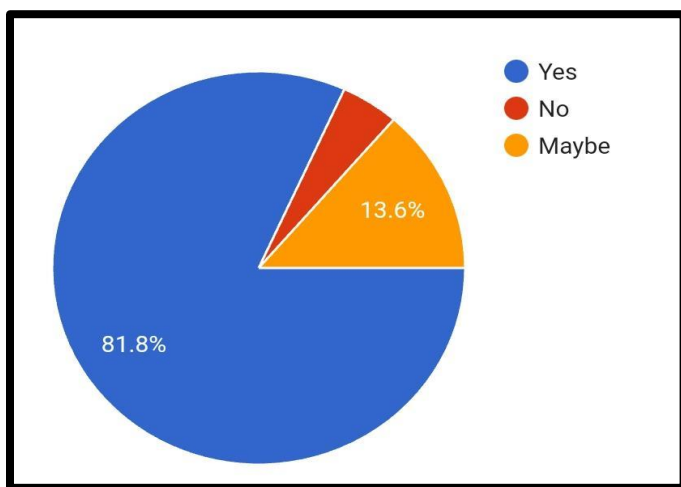
1. Did you enjoy the event?



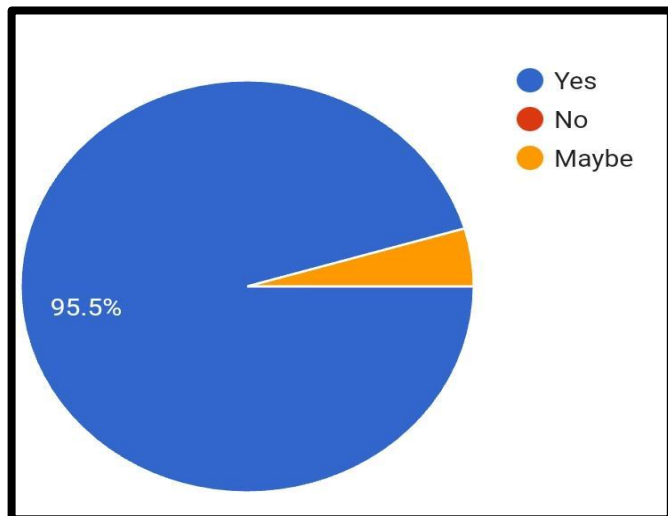
2. Was dressing up in traditional attire and celebrating the festival was a great experience?
