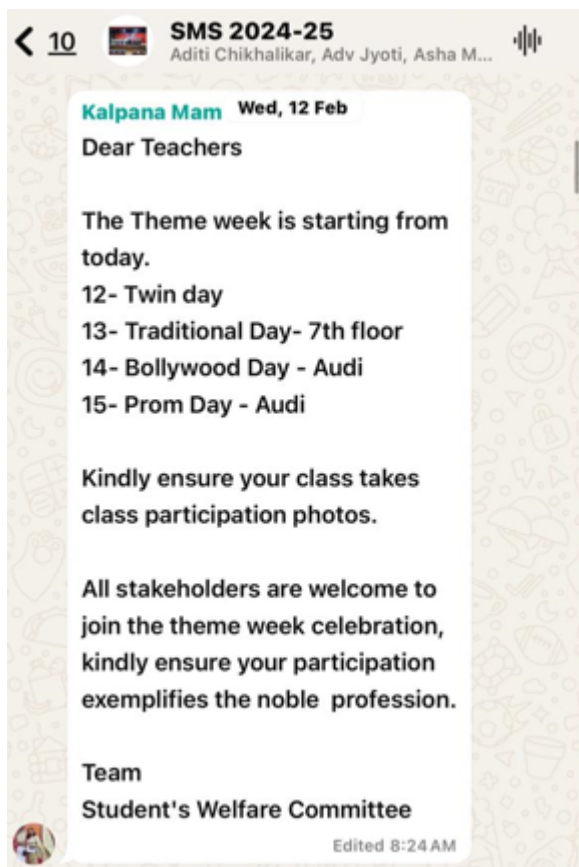

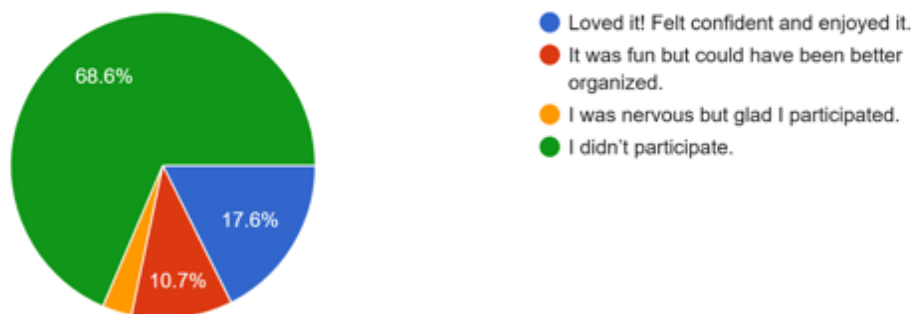

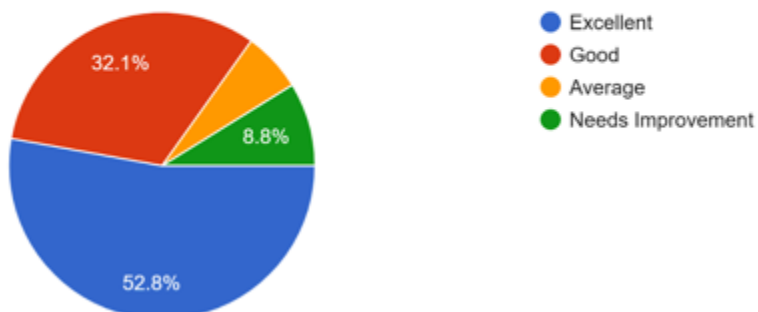
If you participated in the ramp walk, how was your experience?
