Strategies for effective communication and outreach programs.

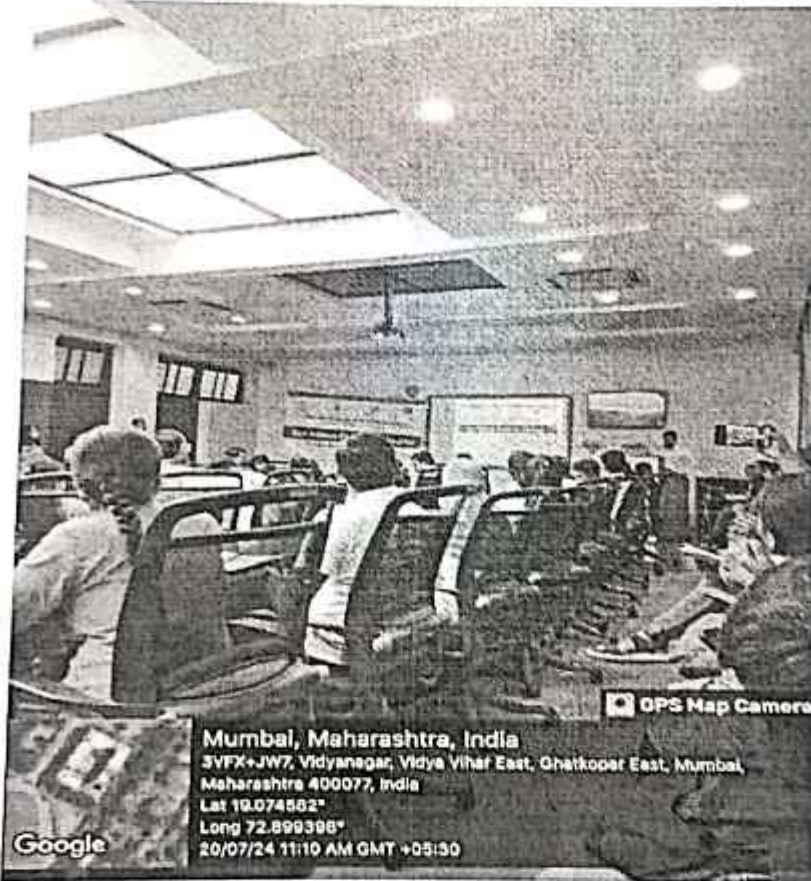
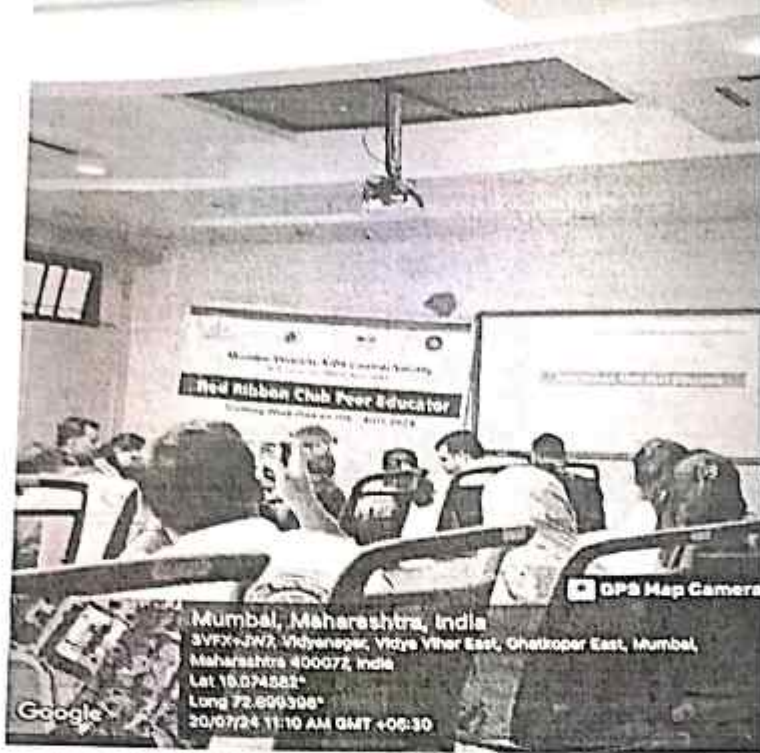
Group activities and role-plays to simulate real-life scenarios.

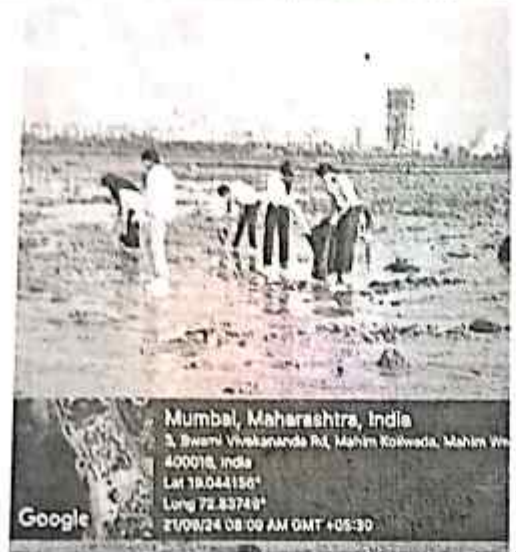
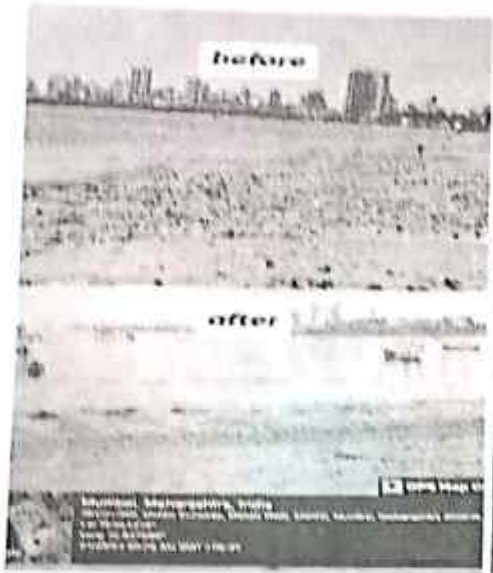
Impact

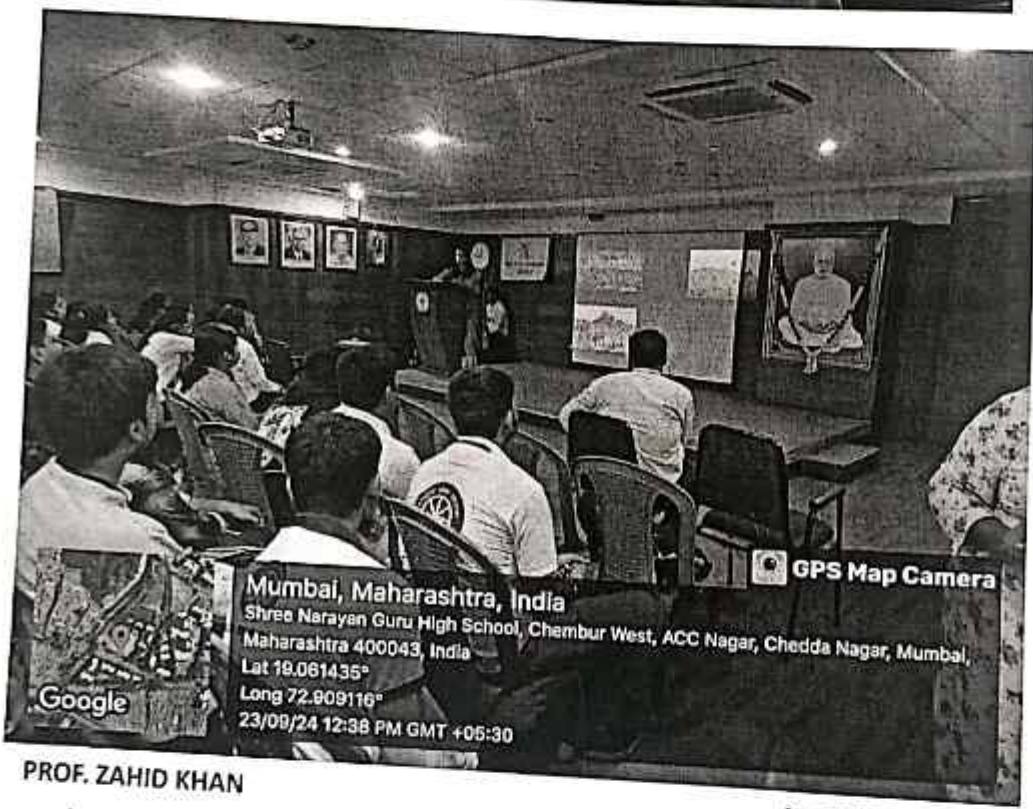
The interactive nature of the session, along with real-life examples shared by the resource person, engaged the participants and highlighted how they can contribute to sustainable waste management practices in their communities.

Volunteers engaged in conversations with the public, answering questions and providing important road safety tips.

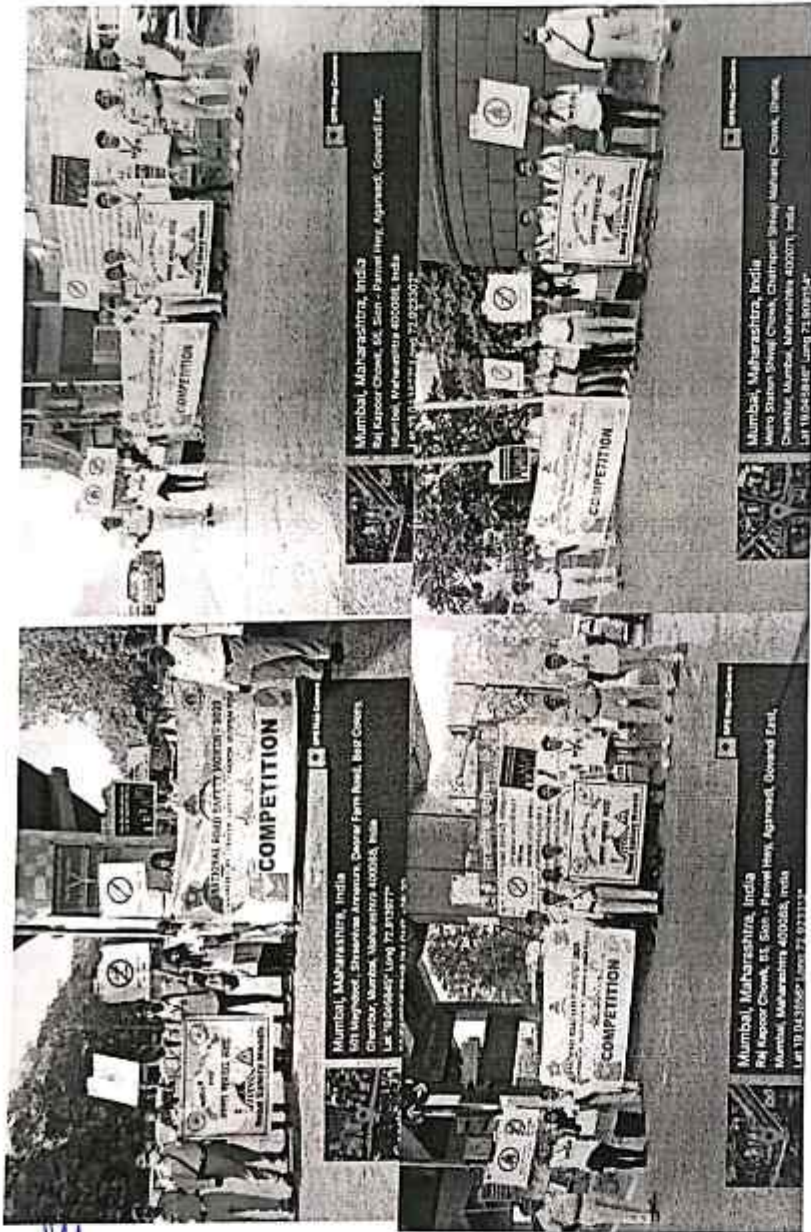
3. **Demonstrations and Placards:**

A total of **7 volunteers** participated in the event, playing key roles in delivering the performance and engaging with the audience.

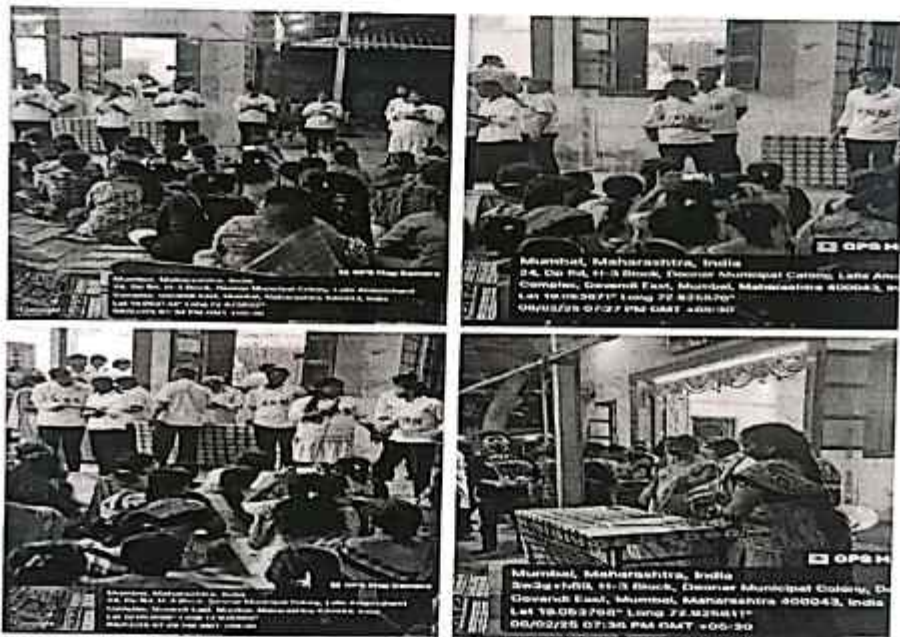



Conclusion:


Recommendations for Future Events:




Police Station proved to be a powerful approach in spreading awareness and inspiring the community to take a stand against drug abuse.
